The Board previously established a CSA Revenue Task Force earlier this year to review the community's critical funding needs. CSA President, Sam Bennett presented the short term plan related to our Community Funding. The CSA Board, at the recommendation of the CSA Revenue Task Force, authorized staff to develop a plan with the CSA Finance Committee and CSA Maintenance, Enhancement, and Major Project Committee to use \$2.5 million dollars in current investments to address critical infrastructure needs over the next 18 months. The CSA Revenue Task Force is working toward an end of the summer recommendation in regards to long term community infrastructure funding.

Gate Entry Amendments

The Board approved two amendments to the Gate Entry Policy as follows:

Regarding Multi Owner Decals, ID Cards; Properties with multiple owners, e.g. LLC's, trusts whose names are specifically listed on these legal documents are considered RPOs and will be limited to four (4) free property owner decals and property owner photo ID cards, not to exceed fourteen (14) owners/partners. A surcharge per decal (5-14), to be determined by Board of Directors. Staff are working through the process to implement this new portion of the policy and we look forward to communicating with the community once the process is set.
