- Collection of Assessment Fees, 2022, underway. To date, 600 Residential Property Owners' assessment fees remain unpaid;
- o Property Owners still in arrears, to lose ability to call in gate passes, March, 2022;
- o Books, 2021, remain open until invoice for North Sea Pines Drive project, submitted;
- o Funds for uncompleted projects, 2021, to be rolled forward. Budget amendment, to this effect, to be brought at March 29, 2022, Sea Pines CSA Board Meeting;
- o Independent audit to be performed week of February 21, 2022.
