The support we receive from Sea Pines property owners is important to the Heritage Classic Foundation. We are thankful for the opportunity to share your beautiful community with the golf world.

We wanted you to be aware of changes we are making around Harbour Town Golf Links for this year's tournament. In addition to the rope lines we have installed over the last several years, we are adding 4-foot mesh fencing to key high-traffic areas. The plan to secure the perimeter is supported by CSA, The Sea Pines Resort and is recommended by the PGA TOUR for the safety of all.

This fencing aims to keep non-ticketed people off the course and will also help keep spectators off homeowners' property. Safety is a top priority of the RBC Heritage staff and the PGA TOUR. Fencing in high traffic areas adds an additional layer of precaution that the PGA TOUR has been requesting from us.

The volunteer tent, formerly located on Plantation Drive behind the 15th green, will be moving to the corner of Marsh Road and Plantation Drive. This new location will offer volunteers a safer space to access transportation.

We look forward to seeing you at the RBC Heritage Presented by Boeing, April 14-20. From the ceremonious opening boom of the classic cannon to the champion-winning putt in the final round, everyone's teed up for a legendary time.
